



Quarantine Barn Daily Standard Operating Procedures (DSOP)

1. Sign in with complete date on sign in sheet. This includes all trainees and visitors.
2. Immediately check all equines to be sure they are standing or acting normally. If not contact Barn Manager.
3. Prepare feed for each equine according to directions given.
4. Feed each of the equines either in their own stall, a holding stall or in paddocks. Make sure they are fed separately.
5. Clean paddocks and or stalls. Remove all manure and old hay that they cannot eat such as hay that has been pushed in mud or peed/defecated on. Dig out any wet spots and sprinkle PDZ if needed. Replace shavings in the stall, look for trash, sticks etc. in paddock and remove.
6. If water containers are dirty, empty, clean and fill with fresh water.
7. Place hay out according to feeding instructions. If there is clean hay left from the last feed adjust the amount needed.
8. Depending on weather turn out or bring horses in.
9. Fill out daily feed chart on each equine.
10. Sweep or blow out aisle.
11. Before leaving check:
 - all stalls to make sure they are closed and bolted
 - chains are on all paddock gates
 - all faucets are turned off
 - all lights are off
 - close windows if horses are in stalls and weather dictates
12. Sign out
13. Close the big barn doors. If it's a hot day, leave the doors slightly open to permit a breeze.
